EDUC 8321: Diversity/Equity Leadership

Students will reflect and examine topics such as race and ethnicity, class, gender, language, and disability as they relate to equity. Students will develop the ability to build cross-cultural relationships across multiple constituencies for the purpose of impacting student/employee performance, promoting social justice, and building community. By studying current research on diversity and equity, candidates will learn to advocate and promote excellence in educational institutions and complex organizations.
